



2018 EcoDistricts Incubator Application

EcoDistricts is now accepting neighborhood team applications for the 2018 Incubator cycle. The 2018 Incubator will take place May 9-11 in Portland, Oregon. **The application will close January 31, 2018.** All applicants will be notified of the status of their application no later than March 1, 2018. Participation Fee and Expenses

Registration for the 2018 Incubator is \$8,000.00 for up to 5 project team members. Registration for additional team members is priced at \$1,800.00 per person with a maximum of 7 total people per team. Registration fees include breakfast and lunch each day, an assigned expert facilitator per team for the length of the convening, and all educational materials. Lodging and transportation costs are not included in the registration fees. Discounts and/or partial scholarships are available for nonprofit and/or community groups.

Thanks to the generous support of our partners, EcoDistricts can cover the full registration cost (\$8,000) of one Portland-based neighborhood team to attend the 2018 Incubator. We are thrilled to offer this opportunity to a local project working to make Portland's neighborhoods more equitable, sustainable, and resilient for all.
